Los poemas de Bajo la luz de mi sangre buscan pintar inquietantes temas descubiertos en la memoria viva del poeta, permitindoles aflorar, como su vida en Cuba, la patria donde naci. La poesia toma aqu la premisa de que el lenguaje es un medio para experimentar experiencias. The poems in Under the Light of my Blood seek to paint unsettling issues discovered in living memory, allowing them to awaken, like the life of the poet in Cuba, where Jorge Enrique was born. The texts become a search for identity, or an interior autobiography chronicling events that occurred between the poets birth and his exile. Poetry takes as its premise that language is a medium for experiencing experiences.
