He became the youngest player to lead the league in both on-base percentage and homers in the same season since Ty Cobb in 1909. Through 2015, he has a career .902 OPS (143) OPS+), the same OPS and adjusted OPS that Henry Aaron had through his first four seasons-and Hammerin Hank was nearly a year older!...
