Doubtless in Georgia they encountered the northern migrations of a southern or southwestern type of bison, the bison of Louisiana, but probably it, too, was closely related to the Pennsylvania type. The lengthy migrations were hardly in keeping with known characteristics of the wood bison of Colorado, Wyoming and Montana and of the Canadian northwest.
